Fees and Scholarships

Tuition Fee (per person): 2,770 USD (will be granted as scholarships) Local Expense Fee (per person): Single Occupancy (one person in a room) 5,450 USD

Each scholarship covers the tuition fee of the programme. Kindly note that it does not cover the local expenses fee nor airfare.
