On May **23-24, 2017**, CKTT organized a presentation of Services Catalogue and the Catalogue of Lifelong Learning in the Karolinum premises in the form of the Via Carolina trade fair.

The two-day event was started by the **press conference** with the participation of the Rector of Charles University – prof. Tomas Zima. In the premises of Karolinum, there were field-related stands were organized to show the results, innovations, and already developed functioning models of cooperation with industry.
